<b>VACATION</b>	Two weeks per year	30 Days per Year
<b>SICK LEAVE</b>	Limited	Unlimited with full pay and allowances
<b>MEDICAL/ DENTAL</b>	Possible professional discount	<b>FREE</b>
<b>TRAVEL</b>	At own expense	Military facilities around the world and space available flights overseas
<b>RECREATION</b>	At own expense	Officers Club, golf courses, fitness centers, etc at reduced rates, planned family activities
<b>CONTINUED EDUCATION</b>	Possible reimbursement	Programs available for tuition Army pays for 75-100% of all tuition cost
<b>RETIREMENT</b>	Social Security at 62 and own retirement plan	Eligible for retirement after 20 yrs. Active service
<b>PAY RAISES</b>	As determined by civilian institution	Automatic raises every 2 yrs
<b>SHOPPING</b>	Civilian stores	Reduced prices at Base Exchange and Commissary, Garden Hop, etc
