Office of Admissions and Records Request to Appeal Residency for Tuition Purposes

All appeals are due the Friday before classes start to be considered for the current term. Any appeals submitted after this date will still be considered but only for the subsequent term.

An individual whose Application for Residency is disapproved by the Office of Admissions and Recordsmay appeal the decision in accordance with Title 4, Chapter 15 of the Board of Regents Handbook, "Regulations for determining residency and tuition charges." The appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days of the initial decision. If an appeal is not filed within this time frame the decision of the Office of Admissions and Records becomes final. The granting of resident (in-state) student status will apply only to the semester for which this appeal is accepted and approved along with future terms. No decision shall be retroactive.

The following is required for a complete appeal:

- 1. Completion of this form (this includes all relevant fields below as forms determined to be incomplete may be denied).
- 2. Any written statement consisting of a summary of relevant facts/circumstances in a complete and concise manner.
